

PRIVACY POLICY

Last Revised:

This Privacy Policy, as amended or otherwise changed from time to time (the "Privacy Policy"), explains the manner in which Tokenomika Malta Limited (hereinafter "Tokenomika" or "Tokenomika Malta Limited") maintains and discloses user information obtained through its website sto.tokenomika.com (the "Site"). The terms "we," "us," and "our" refer to Tokenomika Malta Limited. By using the Site, you ("User") consent to the data practices prescribed in this Privacy Policy. On occasion, Tokenomika Malta Limited may revise this Privacy Policy to reflect changes in law, our personal data collection and use practices, the features on the Site, or advances in technology. If material changes are made to this Privacy Policy, the changes will be prominently posted on the Site.

What if I do not want to accept this Privacy policy?

By using this Site, you signify your acceptance of this policy. If you do not agree to this policy, please do not use our Site. Your continued use of the Site following the posting of changes to this policy will be deemed as your acceptance of those changes.

If you have already registered an account, you can find out how to terminate or cancel your account here.

What information does Tokenomika collect?

We collect Personal Data and Anonymous Data, as described below.

We may collect Personal Data from you, such as:

- your first and last name;
- e-mail and mailing addresses;
- date of birth;
- government issued identification;
- photographs;
- information about financial statement;
- information about working status;
- gender;
- utility bills;
- phone number.

If you provide us feedback or contact us via e-mail, we will collect your name and e-mail address, as well as any other content included in the e-mail, in order to send you a reply.

Some information is collected automatically by our servers:

- Our servers (which may be hosted by a third party service provider) collect information from you, including your browser type, operating system, Internet Protocol ("IP") address (a number that is automatically assigned to your computer when you use the Internet, which may vary from session to session), domain name, and/or a date/time stamp for your visit.
- As is true of most websites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes IP addresses, browser type, Internet service provider ("ISP"), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data.
- Like many online services, we use cookies to collect information. "Cookies" are small pieces of information that a website sends to your computer's hard drive while you are viewing the website.
- We retain information on your behalf, such as transactional data and other session data linked to your Account.

We do not collect any **Special Categories of Personal Data** about you (this includes details about your race or ethnicity, religious or philosophical beliefs, sex life, sexual orientation, political opinions, trade union membership, information about your health and genetic and biometric data).

How does Tokenomika use the information it collects?

In general, Personal Data you submit is necessary for company's incorporation process and for preparation of documents for securities' offering: we collect your data and transfer it to our partners that will help you with incorporation. Our partners need such data to comply with Know-Your-Customer purposes and for completing necessary documents for you.

All data collected automatically will be used to administer or improve our Services.

- We use IP address to make our Site and Services more useful to you, and to perform identity verification.
- We use information from log files to analyze trends, administer the Site, track users' movements around the Site, gather demographic information about our user base as a whole, and better tailor our Services to our users' needs. Except as noted in this Privacy Policy, we do not link this automatically-collected data to Personal Data.
- We may use both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on our Site. This type of information is collected to make the Site more useful to you and to tailor the experience with us to meet your special interests and needs.

We may create Anonymous Data records from Personal Data by excluding information (such as your name) that makes the data personally identifiable to you. We use this Anonymous Data to analyze request and usage patterns so that we may enhance the content of our Services and improve Site navigation. We reserve the right to use Anonymous Data and aggregated and other de-identified information for any purpose and disclose Anonymous Data to third parties in our sole discretion.

Tokenomika does not sell user and / or Anonymous Data to any third party.

How does Tokenomika share my Personal Data?

It may be necessary to disclose your information to comply with any law, court orders, or government request, defend against claims, investigate or bring legal action against illegal or suspected illegal activities, enforce our Terms, or to protect the rights, safety, and security of Tokenomika, our users, or the public.

We may share your Personal Data with third party service providers to provide you with the services that we offer you through our Site; These third party service providers are required not to use your Personal Data other than to provide the services requested by you.

Other than as stated in this Privacy Policy, Tokenomika does not disclose any of your personal information to third parties unless required to do so by law enforcement, court order, or in compliance with legal reporting obligations.

How we transfer collected information internationally

We may transfer the collected information we obtain from you to recipients in countries other than the country in which the information was originally collected. Those countries may not have the same data protection laws as the country in which you initially provided the information.

The collected information may be transferred to a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). All data transfers outside the EEA are made under agreements and include all necessary standard data protection clauses adopted by a supervisory authority. These providers acting in a fully-compliant manner with GDPR.

What legal rights do you have in relation to your information?

Under certain circumstances, you have the following rights under data protection laws in relation to your personal data:

- Request access to your personal data.
- Request correction of your personal data.
- Request erasure of your personal data.
- Object to processing of your personal data.
- Request restriction of processing your personal data.
- Request transfer of your personal data.
- Right to withdraw consent.

NO FEE USUALLY REQUIRED

You will not have to pay a fee to access your personal data (or to exercise any of the other rights).

Request the transfer of your personal data to you or to a third party. We will provide to you, or a third party you have chosen, your personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format. Note that this right only applies to automated information which you initially provided consent for us to use or where we used the information to perform a contract with you.

Withdraw consent at any time where we are relying on consent to process your personal data. However, this will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before you withdraw your consent. If you withdraw your consent, we may not be able to provide certain products or services to you. We will advise you if this is the case at the time you withdraw your consent. Please note that in certain circumstances it may be still lawful for us to continue processing your information even where you have withdrawn your consent, if one of the other legal bases is applicable.

How can you send requests regarding your information?

Unless you have made a corresponding request, we will retain your information for as long as your Account has not been closed or as needed to provide you access to your Account.

If you wish to close your Account, open a ticket in our support center. We will retain and use your information as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our Terms.

How does Tokenomika use cookies and persistent local data?

We collect web browser Information in order to enhance your experience on the site and track how the Services are being used. Cookies are small data files that are stored on your computer's hard drive, and in addition to using cookies to provide you with a better user experience, we use cookies to identify and prevent fraudulent activity. The information collected can include, but is not limited to, your IP address, referral URLs, the type of device you use, your operating system, the type of browser you use, geographic location, and other session data. Cookies are not permanent and will expire after a short time period of inactivity. You may opt to deactivate your cookies, but it is important to note that you may not be able to access or use some features of our site. Please note that Tokenomika is not responsible or can be held liable for any loss resulting from your decision or inability to use such features.

What security precautions does Tokenomika take to protect me?

We take the protection of your personal information seriously. We use industry-standard data encryption technology and have implemented restrictions related to the storage of and the ability to access your personal information. However, despite all of our efforts, please note that no transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage can be guaranteed to be 100% secure.
